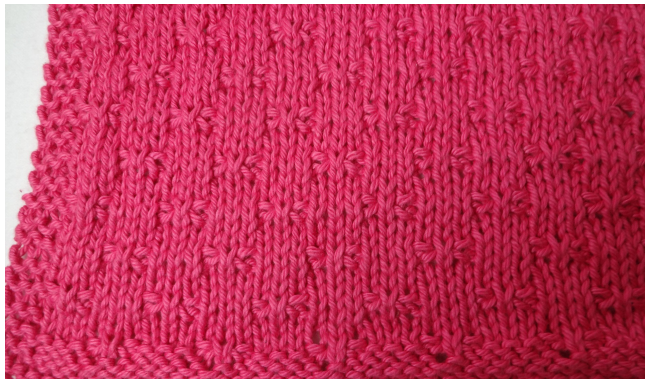


CREEPY BUT CLEAN

I thought the close up of this pattern looked like little spiders, hence the name.



Materials: Knit Picks Comfy, a 75% Pima cotton 25% acrylic yarn in Sport weight. 136 Yards/50 grams. One ball will do two cloths depending on the size you make. I used the color called zinnia. A jewel-like pink.

Needle size: 5

Gauge: It doesn't matter. My piece is 9" x 8".

Cast on 42 (This can be sized up or down. The pattern is a multiple of 6 plus the 6 border stitches.)

Rows 1-3: K.

Row 4: k 3, p until 3 sts remain, k 3.

Row 5: k

Row 6: k 3, *p3, k3 repeat from * to within 3 sts remain, end k3.

Row 7: k3, *p1, k into next st in the row below, p1, k3 repeat from * end k 3.

Row 8: k3, p to within 3 sts, end k3.

Row 9: k

Row 10: k 3, *k3, p3, repeat from * end k3.

Row 11 k3, *k3, p1k k into next stitch in the row below, p1, repeat from * end k3.

Repeat rows 4 -11 until piece is as large as you want it.

Next 3 rows: k.

Bind off all stitches. Weave in ends.
