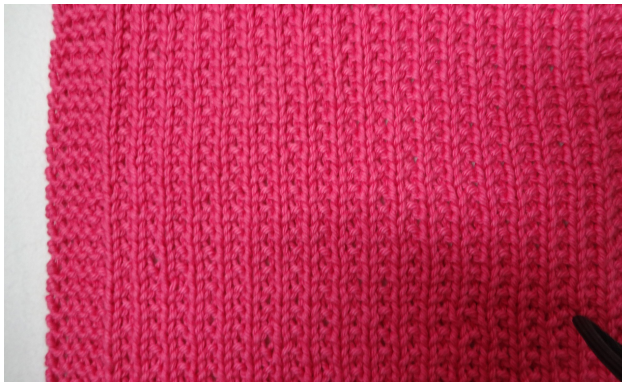


WISHY WASHY

An Annie Lewis Marion original.



Materials: Knit Picks Comfy, a 75% Pima cotton 25% acrylic yarn in Sport weight. 136 Yards/50 grams. One ball will do two cloths depending on the size you make. I used the color called zinnia. A jewel-like pink.
Two stitch markers and a small safety pin.

Needle size: 5.

Gauge: It doesn't really matter but my cloth is 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cast on 45 sts. (If you want a different size the pattern is an odd number of stitches).

Rows 1-5: Knit

Row 6: K5, place marker, these 5 sts will be knitted every row, k1, *p1, k1 repeat from * to within 5 sts of end, place marker, k5, these 5 sts will also remain knitted every row as a border. Place a pin in this row to mark this as the right side.

Row 7: K5, slip marker, purl to next marker, k5.

Repeat until the whole piece is 8" long.

Next row: Knit. Repeat for 4 more rows for 5 rows of border matching the 5 rows at the beginning.

Bind off all sts and weave in all ends.
